1. **Hannah's Treasure Chest:** Children in need who don't have necessary living items.
2. **The Foodbank:** Children and families to relieve hunger.
3. **Make a Wish:** Money goes to children with terminal illnesses.
4. **St. Jude's:** Funding research for childhood cancer and other life-threatening diseases.
5. **House of Bread:**
 - a. \$365, \$1 a day in honor of our ability to open and provide services every day of the year -- otherwise known as Club 365!
 - b. \$250, covers the cost of morning coffee service to our guests for 10 days
 - c. \$150, pays for dishwashing and cleaning supplies for 1 month
 - d. \$120, or \$10 a month, pays for 10 gallons of salad dressing
6. **Operation Smile:** Goes towards surgeries for children with cleft lip.
7. **The Dayton Foundation Tragedy Fund:** In response to the mass shooting that occurred in the early hours of August 4, 2019, the Dayton Oregon District Tragedy Fund allows individuals to make charitable contributions to help the families directly affected by this terrible tragedy.
